#### Steps to receive a rebate:

1. Call 791-2663 to schedule an inspection of your existing irrigation system.
2. Staff will make recommendations to improve your irrigation system's efficiency.
3. Purchase and install approved irrigation products\* to improve your system.
4. Complete rebate application and attach copies of your original itemized receipts. (Contractor's itemized invoices must include their original material receipts. The District rebates amount of contractor's cost price only.)
5. Call SJWD at 791-2663 to schedule a walk-thru appointment to verify installation of irrigation materials. Staff will pick up your application and original receipts during this visit.
6. Staff will review your application and receipts to determine rebate eligibility. 50% of the cost of eligible irrigation materials will be considered for rebate up to the maximum allowed and applied in accordance with Item 10 under Terms and Conditions on page 2 of this application.

- precision nozzles
- rotary nozzles
- adjustable rotary nozzles
- matched precipitation rotator nozzles
- replacement rotors for impact sprinklers
- wind fighting rotators for pastures
- pressure compensating canisters
- weather sensors

- check valves
- pressure reducers
- flexible pipe to retrofit existing systems
- rain sensors
- inline drip tubing, drip connectors, drip tie downs, drip conversion kits

## Terms and Conditions

1. The Irrigation Improvement Rebate Program is administered by SJWD.
2. All eligible irrigation products must be purchased and installed between July 1, 2013 and June 30, 2014.
3. Eligible irrigation products\* were determined by SJWD staff to improve water and irrigation efficiencies.
4. Eligibility:
  - a. Property address where irrigation materials are installed must be located in the SJWD retail service area.
  - b. Applicant must have an active water account in good standing with SJWD.
  - c. Applicant must have an existing underground irrigation system with an operable automatic controller.
  - d. Current controller must have at least two of the following deficiencies to be eligible for replacement:
    - o Allows only one watering program
    - o Does not allow one minute watering increments
    - o Does not allow multiple program start times
    - o Does not allow for a rain sensor
    - o Does not allow programming for interval watering days and individual watering days
  - e. Applicant must agree to a Landscape Irrigation Review (LIR) prior to upgrading irrigation system.
  - f. Applicant must make a follow-up appointment with SJWD staff to verify installation of irrigation materials to be eligible for a rebate.
6. SJWD and/or its staff shall not be held responsible for any controller or irrigation system malfunctions, changes in Applicant's water use, or any damage to landscape as a result of landscapes adjusting to changes in watering schedules.
7. SJWD reserves the right to verify the purchase and installation location of any system for which a rebate is requested.
8. Rebate program is subject to available funding. Rebates will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis until funding is depleted. Submission of an application does not guarantee a rebate.
9. SJWD will reimburse up to 50% of total qualifying material cost with corresponding receipts (labor to install irrigation equipment not included). Maximum rebate is \$500 per residential site and \$1,500 per commercial site.
10. Rebate will be issued in the form of an account credit. 50% of Applicant's rebate will be applied after installation and inspection of materials. The remaining 50% will be issued in the form of an account credit after one year if water use at Applicant's property decreased during the year after improvements were made.
11. Retain your completed application form and your original sales receipt(s) until all planned improvements have been completed and installation of all irrigation materials has been verified by SJWD staff.
